The Courses

Young English World

Our intensive Young English World course builds English language skills, helps develop teamworking and leadership and builds confidence in performing.

The course includes 25 hours per week of structured English language lessons and team performance projects, plus afternoon sports or activities.

Young English World Exam Preparation

We offer preparation for the Cambridge B2 First and C1 Advanced exams. Students can take the exam on site during the course. The programme includes dedicated Exam Preparation sessions and Language Structure and Skills sessions. Afternoon sports and activities follow the learning programme.

Typical school day

08.00	Breakfast with homestay
09.00–09.30	Morning briefing
09.30–10.30	Language skills
10.45–11.45	Language structure
12.00–13.00	Interest based learning or Exam English
13.00–13.30	Lunch
13.30–15.30	Performance Project or Exam English
16.00–18.00	Activities
19.00–20.30	Evening event or Evening with homestay host

What's included: Full board accommodation, tuition and activity programme, 1 full day and 1 half day excursion per week.

The Homestay Experience

Staying with a local homestay host allows students to learn more about everyday life in the UK and gives them a unique opportunity to speak English in real-life situations. Mealtimes encourage students to interact with their hosts and help them feel more comfortable using English in everyday life

Most hosts live within a 20 minute walk from the school.

At least 3 nights a week students come back to school for an evening event. This is the perfect opportunity to use the English learnt in a social setting. Popular events include the beacholympics, discos and music/drama shows.

Full day and half day excursions

Each week we take students on a half day excursion to a local place of interest, and a full day Saturday excursion to great cities like Winchester, Oxford, Bath and London. We help them to get the most from their trip by preparing them in advance with observation tasks or lively photo challenges.
