



The All English Course

Summer English + Activity Course for children and teenagers

- Improves accuracy and fluency in English
- Enhances life skills by developing confidence in English
- Small classes and high teacher to student ratio
- Age range: 11–12 years and 13–17 years

Outcomes

Increased confidence

Improvement in the level of written and spoken English

Course programme

The programme includes sessions which gives the student the tools they need to operate confidently and successfully when using English as an international language.

The Language structure lessons provide practice in writing, in listening comprehension and in reading comprehension. This includes the development of vocabulary and how to structure a piece of written work.

The Writing skills lessons revise core grammar skills and works on the eradication of common errors.

In the Speaking skills lessons, the student develops confidence and skills in a range of speaking situations.

In the Project session, the student develops the skills of interaction and collaboration with others.

Course content

This intensive course includes 20 hours of study per week (taught in small classes of 8 per class). This enables the learner to develop all-round skills and to gain increased confidence in their use of English.

Entry level

Beginner to advanced.

Certificate

At the end of the course, each student receives a certificate of achievement, showing the level achieved.

Afternoon activity programme

The afternoon programme includes sports, games, competitions and hobby clubs.

Evening activity programme

The evening activity programme includes outdoor games, drama club, music nights, movie nights, fashion shows and talent shows.

Excursions

There is one full day excursion per week. Typical destinations include Oxford and London.

Accommodation

Students live in the school residence and stay in either single or double bedrooms. Bathrooms are shared.

Included in the course

- 20 hours of English lessons per week.
- All course materials.
- Fully-supervised afternoon activity programme.
- One full day excursion per week.
- All meals.
- Accommodation in the school residence in single or double bedrooms.
- End of course certificate.

Airport Transfers on Arrival and Departure

The Arrival and Departure transfer service is offered to students arriving into and departing from London Heathrow airport. Students are met by School Staff on Arrival Day and escorted to the school camp. Students are escorted by School Staff to the airport on Departure Day.

This service is also available for students arriving into/departing out of London Gatwick Airport but we strongly recommend parents to arrange flights into and out of London Heathrow airport which is located within easy reach of the school camp.
