A choice of English World course programmes for teenagers and young adults

The English World course and the English World preparation course are good options for teenagers and young adults who wish to use their summer vacation to study English in central London.

English World

The English World course offers a programme of 20 hours tuition per week, taught in small groups (maximum 5 per class). The school day runs from 0900 hrs to 1445 hrs from Monday to Friday. After lessons, students are welcome to stay in school and use the guiet study spaces for lesson preparation, revision or reading. The school coffee lounge is available all day for tea and coffee. Alternatively, students can use their afternoons to explore London and visit places of interest. School staff are happy to make suggestions about interesting places to visit. The school timetable allows students to maximise the experience of living in central London and enjoy the parks, culture, sports and entertainment options available. The school's location allows easy connections to all parts of London.

The small class size allows students to practise and develop the key skills for higher education, improve their weak areas and grow their confidence.

The programme improves the learner's accuracy and fluency and develops the key skills of:

- Essay Writing
- Comprehension
- Text Analysis
- Pronunciation
- Rich vocabulary
- Presentation

The course offers students a good way to combine intensive study with a memorable cultural experience. The course is a good choice for students who are preparing for higher education or for end of school exams or for university entrance exams.

English World IELTS preparation

The English World IELTS preparation course is designed for students who need to sit the IELTS test for entry into university or higher education. The small class size allows tutors to give personal attention to each stent and to coach them in the specific requirements of the exam.

Students can choose to add additional one-to-one lessons to either the English World course or the English World IELTS exam preparation course. This allow the student to work on very specific objectives with the tutor. This option is typically chosen by students who need to achieve a specific exam score and who prefer to work in a focussed way towards their personal objective.

For students wishing to sit the exam at the end of their course, the school can help with checking place availability at nearby exam test centres.
